

International Day 2010 : Funds Statement

As in previous years, this year, too, a large part of the funds raised on International day through various efforts – the sale of books, food and refreshments, tombola and raffle tickets etcetera – will be donated to charities who participate on the day in addition to the schools and the MUN group.

Here is how the allocation of funds is envisaged/planned –

35% of the total will be divided between the participating charities. These include the Red Cross and Amnesty International (with the purpose of the funds being earmarked for reconstruction efforts in Chile and Haiti). Also, the Italian charity Fata Turkana which supports the development of people living in northern Kenya.

40% of the total will be used towards the expenses of the Mini United Nation's annual trip to the Hague. This helps cover the some of the cost of transport and lodging for the students who represent the CIV at this prestigious event. (The MUN is a debating club based at the CIV. Participation in the club's activities is open to all students of the International sections at Eganaude, Niki St. Phalle and the CIV.)

25% will be shared/dispursed between all participating schools and each school may use the funds as per their needs
